VT-ACSS Board 2008-2009 Election

1. The board election of Association of Chinese Students and Scholars (ACSS) at Virginia Tech is founded on principle of democracy, equity and justness. All of the board members are elected democratically. All the Chinese students and scholars registered at Virginia Tech own the rights to equal suffrage as well as the right to contest elections without any discrimination.
2. The VT-ACSS board consists of president, vice-president, secretary, treasure, officer, chair of the Department of Public Relation, chair of the Department of Sports and chair of the Department of Culture and Arts. All of the board members are elected democratically.
3. The last week of April every year is the Election Week, during which all the new board members are elected democratically. The election procedure is organized by executive VT- ACSS board and is monitored by all the VT-ACSS members.
4. All the candidates must be the Chinese students or scholars registered at Virginia Tech.
5. General procedures: First phase, all the participating Chinese students and scholars vote to generate the new board; Second phase, the president and other functionaries are elected by the board on duty and the coming board through voting.

Online voting system opens. New board members' list and ballots will be posted after voting ends.

April 26, 2008 14:00 (Saturday Afternoon)

Extended board meeting starts. Elect new president and other officers by executive boards and new board members. Then the new president and other officers' list will be posted.
